## Eulogy Assignment

A eulogy is a speech given at a funeral, usually by someone who knew the person well. The person giving the eulogy mentions funny, sad, or important moments in the deceased person's life, or perhaps the impact he or she had on everyone. The goal is to remember the person fondly, even if he or she was not perfect. (None of us are!)

Your assignment is to write a eulogy for one of the characters in *Shabanu*. You must pretend to be one of the other characters in the book who is speaking about this person. Write a eulogy that is in the "voice" of that character. Mention what you loved or liked about the person, despite their shortcomings. You should also write about what they struggled with and infer why they may have chosen to live their live their life the way that they did.
